Mayor Monette noted a street light out on Main St.

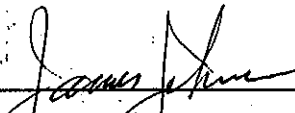
Mayor Monette noted that per the Vt. Dept. of Health, at optimal level of fluoride in drinking water there was no health risk.

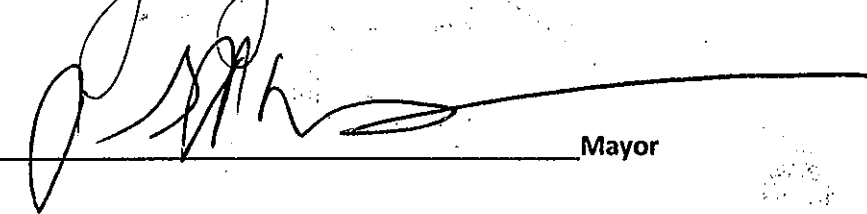
