Minutes of June 16, 2020 Meeting

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the meeting was held remotely.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM.

Upon motion made by Denis Chenette and seconded by Chris Vachon, the minutes of the June 2, 2020, meeting were unanimously approved.

The ongoing plan development discussion centered on the state-mandated components of the new plan. Most of the discussion related to available sites for new business/commercial development or redevelopment in the City. Denis noted that there is an additional commercial lot located near his business location off the Bluff Road. Most of those present were previously unaware of that location.

Mareo advised that the former Sacred Heart school site is still listed for sale and that the asking price has been significantly reduced. Denis said that he has some contacts who may be aware of any prospects for the site which has been vacant for several years and that he will see what can be learned in that regard.

John mentioned that an analytical framework that he had heard mentioned as an approach to the plan is: Maintain-Evolve-Transform.

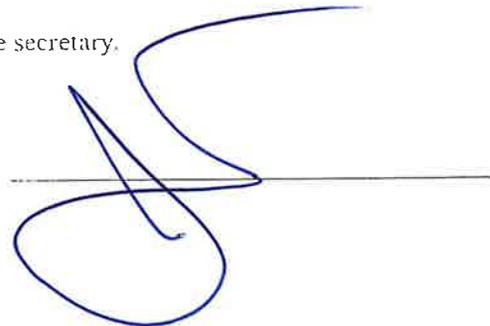
John will contact NVDA regarding materials that it may have that can serve as a basis for the technical information required in the plan.
