# 1. Proposed Bylaw Amendment to section 210/Retail General Intentions

The Planning Commission reviewed revised language presented by Brandy Saxton updating Article 1 sections 210/211.01 of the Newport City Zoning Bylaws. Carole O'Connell made a motion to accept the draft language, approve the amendment as written and deliver it to the Newport City Council for their consideration and potential approval with the full recommendation of the Planning Commission. Denis Chenette seconded the motion, and it was passed unanimously. The Planning commission will formally request that the City Council schedule a public hearing to consider this amendment at the next council meeting.

## 2. Bylaw Modernization Project:

Brandy Saxton coordinated a parcel by parcel evaluation of the proposed zoning district boundary lines. Areas of concern were scrutinized and updated, the process of finalizing the proposed boundary lines will be continued at upcoming working sessions.
